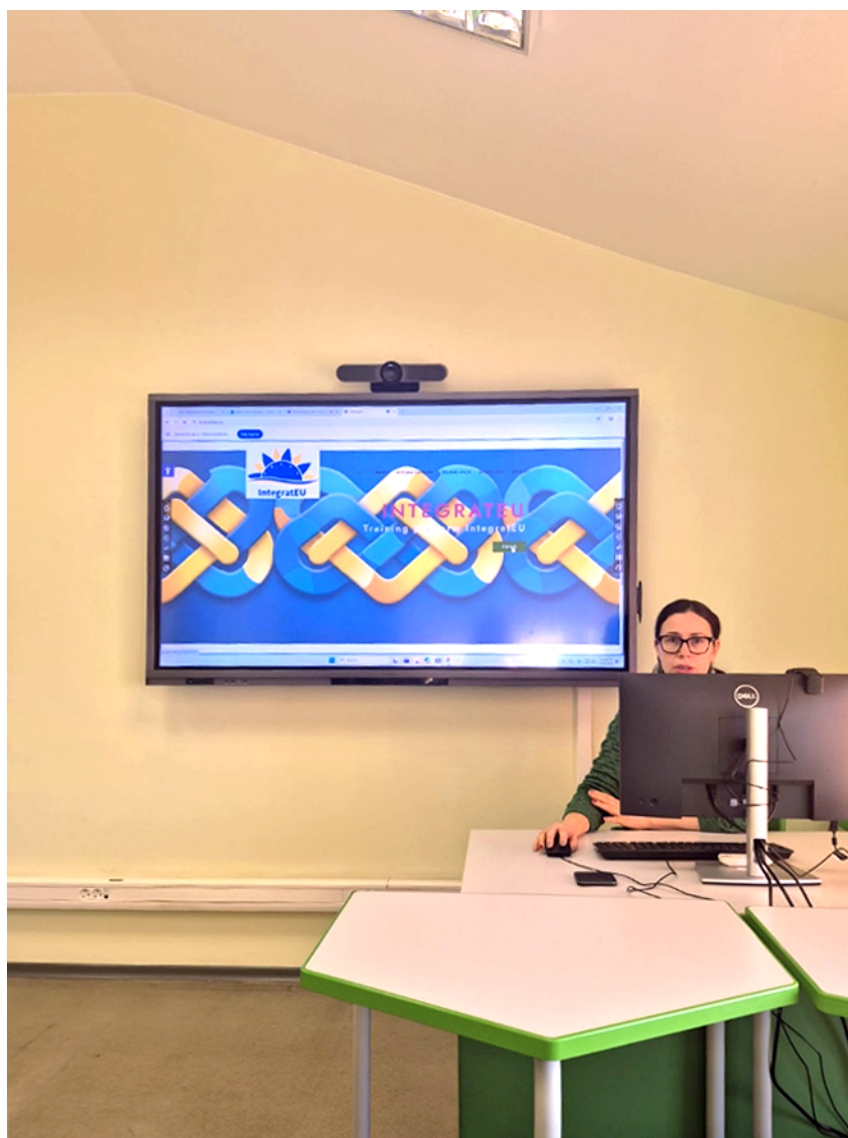
Main Outcomes of INTEGRATEU
