Clarification:

The number of participations (samples/laboratory codes) shall be defined as follows:

- If one participation is declared and all selected characteristics are assigned to that participation, this counts as one participation (one laboratory code / one sample set).
- If more than one participation is declared, the total number of participations shall equal the highest number of participations declared for any selected characteristic (i.e. the maximum declared number across the selected characteristics).
- For pricing purposes, when multiple participations are declared, the “first sample” shall be the participation that includes the greatest number of selected characteristics.
- One proficiency test item is sufficient to perform all declared characteristics for one participation. When more than one participation is declared for one or more characteristics, the number of items provided is determined according to the highest declared number of participations.
