
The Best for a Better World HANYANG VISION 2030



Educational innovation to cultivate future leaders

Hanyang University is constantly striving to foster creative and talented individuals vital to the era of the 4th Industrial Revolution. We are leading true educational innovation through a great deal of investment and support for the latest teaching methodologies, programs, and cutting edge facilities.

Operation of customized courses for social needs

The Industry Advisory Board (IAB) is composed of seven or more members outside the university and is operated by the all departments of Seoul and ERICA Campuses. It advises on the overall curriculum and departmental operations to meet societal demands.

Operation of courses utilizing the latest teaching methods

- Smart Course Flipped Learning, Blended Learning: studies theories online and carries out student-based activities such as debates and team projects offline
- HY-LIVE ver. 3.0 Class Model: Hanyang University is the
 first in the world to use telepresence technology to introduce interactive teaching for university education between teachers and students located far apart from each
 other, creating an illusion that they are in the same space.
 We are continuously upgrading the environment in
 which the courses take place to maximize presence and
 can maximize the effectiveness by engaging students in
 experiments with VR technology as well as holograms.
- Industry-Coupled Problem Based Learning (IC-PBL)
 course established: IC-PBL is an Industry-Coupled Problem Based project lecture method designed to enhance
 various abilities required of future leaders, such as problem
 solving abilities, flexible thinking skills, creativity, cooperation abilities, and communication skills.

IC-PBL classes will allow students to cooperate to find real problems that society and industries are facing, actively search for solutions, and bring results that will positively affect society.

Activation of convergence education for the cultivation of creative students

- Operation of multiple-major system: used by approximately 20% of graduates
- 16 Convergence Majors: Big Data Convergence major, Start Up Convergence major, Future Humanities Convergence major, Social Innovation Convergence major, etc.
- 20 Micro Majors: Fewer requirements compared to multiple majors. Techno-management micro major, Financial Instrument micro major, Art Technology micro major

Expansion of creative hands-on spaces

- CP Factory: An Industry 4.0 research and learning platform that provides a smart factory system
- Fab Lab: A fabrication laboratory where students can experiment with their technical ideas and put them into practice
- Imagine X-lab: A technology design education and research center that utilizes VR/AR equipment
- Business Lab: A preparation area where start-up ideas are created and developed
- Hanyang Art Theater: A cultural art space where performances and training sessions are held to foster creative artists
- HY-Tube Contents Factory: A space for students to create contents, provided for various kinds of infrastructure for real-time live streaming and tools for video production and editing
- White Horizon Studio: A multi-purpose studio that can send out HY-LIVE lectures; and film, edit, and livestream videos with up-to-date infrastructure
- HY-LIVE VR Lab: A VR practice room linked with various labs and practice-based courses and a classroom equipped with multi-display for overall monitoring of multiple practice rooms, and a transmit/receive system that enables the holding of multilateral HY-LIVE classes
- XR Coding Lab: A space equipped with high-end PCs and matrix equipment for various coding practices, and a cooperative coding room where instructors can monitor students' works in real time

Building a sustainable **R&D ecosystem** by strengthening industry-university cooperation

The core of research with future growth potential and sustainability is 'convergence.'

Hanyang University will establish various fusion research organizations to create synergies between academic disciplines, and will create a new research ecosystem by establishing a industry-university cooperation system with many companies.

Convergence between disciplines to secure future research growth engines

Hanyang University has established the MEB (Medicinal Engineering and Bio) Center, a medical convergence center for fusion research in the fields of medicine, engineering, science, and pharmacy. Through the MEB Center, specialized in the life sciences necessary for the future, we will attempt convergence research and exchange among college students and create synergy through academic convergence.

Convergence between industry and university to create a sustainable research ecosystem

Hanyang University operates the Industry University Collaboration Center (IUCC), an industry-university cooperation center that focuses on long-term research that companies cannot pursue. Through the membership of the IUCC, an industry-academia cooperation R&D center, the university focuses on research and education on the basis of stable finance, in addition to the company obtaining the necessary information and research results.

Fostering global intellectuals who can play an active role in the international community

Hanyang University cultivates global intellectuals by assigning mandatory courses in global language and culture, adopting English-specific curriculums, and introducing various internationalization programs. In addition, we have established a global startup base in Shanghai, China, for employment and start-ups.

Providing the best global education environment in Korea

More than 1,000 exchange students and visiting students come to Hanyang University. Hanyang also operates the largest international summer/winter school in Asia, which is attended by over 1,500 students in each intake.

Strengthening the support for international students with various programs

Hanyang University provides practical help for international students from enrollment, bachelor's degree management, scholarship programs, international student events, and counseling. Additionally, Hanyang provides employment education and a job fair for international students, and organizes international students' alumni meetings to help students successfully enter the society as Hanyang alumni.





Cultivation of intellectuals

who can practice love and resolve social issues

Hanyang University's steps to create a better world are unending. Based upon its founding philosophy of 'Love in Deed and Truth,' Hanyang continues its meaningful activities to change the world around us and fulfill social responsibilities.

In addition, Hanyang established the Social Innovation Center to foster socially innovative talents and drive global social innovation and is at the forefront of providing social value creation education.

Love

Established a Volunteer Corps to fulfill the social responsibility of the university

Hanyang established the first Volunteer Corps in Korea in 1994. In 2012, Hanyang established the first alumni community service group. Through this, Hanyang aims to cultivate intellectuals who promote the university's founding philosophy of "Love in Deed and Truth' to fulfill the social responsibility of the university.

Love in Deed and Truth

Hanyang was the first university in Korea to adopt volunteer works as a class subject. In addition, Hanyang has created an environment in which everyone can realize the university's founding philosophy of 'Love in Deed and Truth' through the operation of 'Hanyang Hope,' a volunteer group consisting of students.

Stronger connection between social services and social innovation

On January 1, 2017, the Center for Social Innovation was established with the conviction of social innovation as a modern reinterpretation of 'Love in Deed and Truth'. Through this, Hanyang not only focuses on existing social service activities, but also expands its scope of activities into social innovation that focuses on solving problems around the world.



Action

The first university in Korea to join ASHOKA U, the Global Social Innovation University Network

In 2018, Hanyang University joined the ASHOKA U network with other global universities to lead in social innovation. Hanyang University became the first Ashoka U Changemaker Campus in East Asia, fully recognized for its ability to change the world into a better place based on the establishment of the university's founding philosophy of 'Love in Deed and Truth'. The social innovation curriculum incorporates bachelor's, master's, and doctorate degrees.

Opportunity to share social innovation with young leaders from various countries

Hanyang provides young leaders with an opportunity to broaden their horizons through social innovation. Before the Covid-19 pandemic, Hanyang held the annual Asia-Pacific Youth Exchange Program, Social Venture Youth Exchange Program, and the "Seventeen Hearts Festival" every year for students to share social innovation achievements with one another and interact with youths from different countries. Since COVID-19, the program has been switched to online not to lose interest in solving social problems. Hanyang continues to contribute to promoting students' awareness on SDGs.

Operation of HUGE, the social innovation platform, and creation of various extra-curricular programs for social innovation

Hanyang University operates "HUGE (Hanyang University for Global Engagement)," a platform for students to use their creative ideas to resolve social issues. Hanyang has also created a variety of extra-curricular programs to give students an opportunity to contribute to making the world a better place, and resolving social issues.



Change

Publication of SSIR, an academic journal for global social innovation, to create social values and reinforce students' capabilities

After signing an exclusive contract to publish Korean versions of the journal in 2018, Hanyang University is researching/translating articles published overseas and domestic collective impact cases and distributing them to members of the social innovation ecosystem in Korea (quarterly, around 150 different institutions). The Korean version of SSIR not only provides translations of major articles published overseas, but also serves as a critical platform that researches domestic examples of social innovation/social contributions and distributes them as articles overseas. Students of Hanyang are given an opportunity to translate selected articles into Korean and write articles for domestic cases to acquire hands-on experience, stronger capacity, and develop their careers.

"SDGs Changers Lab," a project that creates textbooks and teaching materials to foster adolescent changemakers

Through the project, Hanyang University has created a number of textbooks and teaching materials such as PLAY AID KID; Maker Play Board Game; SDGs Literacy Board Game Social Innovation Thinking Tool; Exciting Planet Expedition; and Imagine, Make, and Solve — to bring youths closer to SDGs and social innovation and is leading education on social innovation through relevant programs.

2022, 7th Seventeen Hearts Festival

The 7th Seventeen Hearts Festival nurtures change-makers with interest in and responsibility for social issues and local communities and became a place of exchange for them. It shares its accomplishments and efforts on social innovation and contributions with members and partner organizations.




